Updating Servers for Mail Gateway (University-Wide Mail Security System)

We have been using "Kaspersky Security for Linux Mail Server (KLMS)" as university-wide mail security system, which filters attached malware and limits number of spam mails. We are planning to update servers for KLMS. Details are as follows:

1. Date

- > Starting new servers: Wednesday, December 24, 2025
- > Stopping old servers: Wednesday, January 14, 2026

 Depending on status of external mail servers, some servers may send mails through old servers even if we started new servers.

2. Notice

The new servers will use "Kaspersky Secure Mail Gateway (KSMG)." The new servers give <u>difference</u> types of modifications on headers when it detects spam.

- > old servers : "X-<u>KLMS</u>-AntiSpam-Status: spam"
- > new servers : "X-<u>KSMG</u>-AntiSpam-Status: spam"

The new servers give <u>same</u> types of modifications on mail subject when it detects malware or spam. Please check below page if you want to see detail.
