In this guide, we explain the preparatory steps for using GakuNin RDM to manage your research data with a storage service at Nagoya University. The contents of this guide are as follows.



We will explain how to connect to GakuNin RDM to use OneDrive as a storage location for research data.


1. Login to GakuNin RDM

The following instructions explain how to login to GakuNin RDM.


1. 1. Access the GakuNin RDM website (https://rdm.nii.ac.jp).



2. From the upper-right pull-down menu, select "Nagoya University" and press the "Login" button. Note that you can input "Nagoya University" in the menu.




3. You will be automatically transferred to the Nagoya University authentication page. Authenticate yourself using your Tokai National Higher Education and Research System (THERS) ID (ab. 12c. 3456 @f. thers. ac. jp) and password.




4. Select an item concerning the information to be sent to GakuNin RDM, and press the 「同意(Accept)」button.



5. You will be automatically transferred to the Profile setting page. Please enter the required information.



6. When you want to move the Dashboard page, click the "GakuNin RDM" on the top-left of the screen.




2. Connecting OneDrive to GakuNin RDM

We will explain how to set up Drive to use with GakuNin RDM. You can also use NII storage with GakuNin RDM, but at Nagoya University, please usually use OneDrive.

If you can see 「OneDrive - 国立大学法人東海国立大学機構 (OneDrive - THERS)」 in the figure below, please proceed to the explanation below. If you can't see it, please refer to the "OneDrive desktop app settings" explanation at the bottom of this page and make the OneDrive of THERS visible.




 Create a folder for GakuNin RDM. This time, we created it with the name "test." We recommend preparing a different folder for each project.




- 2. Next, we will explain how to link OneDrive storage with your project.

 Note that the instructions on creating a project are in the online


 manual. First, access the project page.
- 3. Go to the "Add-ons" page. Find "OneDrive" in the "Select add-ons" column, and if it says "Enable," click "Enable."




4. Read the OneDrive Add-on Terms, and click "Confirm".




5. In the "Configure Add-ons" section at the bottom of the page, click "Import Account from Profile" to the right of OneDrive.



6. Click the "Import" button in the dialog box.



7. Folders in OneDrive will be displayed, so select the location where the project files will be placed. Use the radio button under "Select" to select the location. Confirm by pressing the "Save" button at the bottom.



8. Confirm that your OneDrive directory is in the Files of your project. If confirmed, you are ready to use your OneDrive storage.
